






HOW MUCH CAPACITY DO WE NEED?

Some ships already have a capacity of 18 000

TEU. This is the equivalent to a train more than 108 km long or a road full of heavy goods vehicles **from Paris to**Rotterdam.

Thames Eastern Crossing NLTTT Proposal

Current Situation - IT IS ROAD ONLY

- Infrastructure is running over capacity
- Consecutive UK Governments have been seeking a satisfactory solution for the last 15 years Consistently rejected a 'bridge' solution.

The NLTTT Solution - ROAD AND RAIL - PLUS TECHNOLOGY

- Two Multi-modal tunnels linking Essex and Kent
- 18m plus diameter tunnels providing a twin deck solution for each tunnel (supports 50 ton Hi-Load containers)
- Top deck three road lanes (motorway grade)
- Lower deck two rail lines for freight & passenger rail traffic









Our Proposed Route (Geology Survey is completed)






- •Connects Major Motorway routes Kent end is ready.....
- •Adjacent to Container ports for direct Rail Transfer.
- •Major road relief for North South Thames crossing .
- = 40% reduction of M25 Traffic
- Potential to connect with proposed N-S and E-W rail upgrades.
 (HS2 and Crossrail 2)
- •18% reduction across London Rail Freight. (frees infrastructure for Passengers)
- ENVIRONMENTALLY SENSITIVE
- AVOIDS POPULATED AREAS
- •GEOLOGY HAS BEEN CHECKED

A SUMMARY OF TRANSPORT BENEFITS





- •Major road relief for North-South Thames crossing and bypassing London = 40% reduction of M25 road Traffic
- •Connects Major Motorway routes For Road Freight E-W and N-S



The Tunnel will provide a major new route for Data fibre trunking avoiding London and connecting to new gateway developments.


"Smart City" and 5G infrastructure will be incorporated throughout.



The Process Going Forward?



- Government has announced its preference but the road only tunnel received adverse public response
- Pressure from stakeholders is likely to grow (especially from London and Kent, and from road users generally)
- Process towards planning consent –DCO rather than hybrid Bill?
